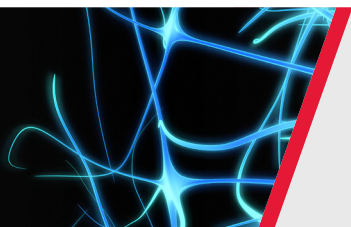
### TRADITIONAL CHARITY CARE
