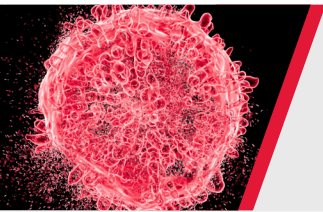
TRADITIONAL CHARITY CARE
